

# Feeding the Birds at Ginninderry

While our bigger birds are easier to notice, and easier to make friends with, feeding them can result in both poor health (as it is not their proper diet) as well as an increase in their population. As these large birds eat the eggs and chicks of small birds, the population of Australia's native small bird species can suffer greatly when large birds are encouraged.

If you'd like to see more small birds in your garden the best thing you can do is provide them with habitat! Plant dense bushes and shrubs that they can hide and nest in. You can also provide a shallow bowl of water for them, especially through the summer months.
